

# THE SOURCE

The Source of material for this Process starts with glass Any type of glass, Ceramic or Porcelain that is thrown in the Ocean / Body of Water.



By the process of chemical and physical weathering over time.

Usually 20-30 years the glass will be broken down into pieces, Barnacles and Seaweed start to trace the glass Apart of its recognition.

Eventually the waves start to push out the sea glass onto shore, cracking clean lines along the beaches.




The waves are the driving motion of force that brings this process together. They help stir the glass in order to break down into pieces.




# THE FLOW






Huile Cable Jacket.

Single Sewn  
Jacket



The jacket goes All  
the way Past a bit  
Of the Hips. The layered  
Cowl starting from  
the waist give the jacket  
its body. Represent  
Ocean waves.

with swirls.



Back of jacket.

18 feet.




The dress below is also layered. It has a cowl that is accompanied with short sleeves but then under has Bishop Sleeves in order to provide warmth to the Client.

## COWL NECK

The Cowl design is supposed to be a visual representation on how the waves contribute to the process of making the sea glass. The Cowl is a perfect silhouette to represent waves in a physical garment form.

Skirt.




## THE GLASS






Because this is a winter collection, the use of a loose tailored silhouette is used for extra elegance and coverage.




Box Pleated  
Skirt will be  
embroidered with  
Seaglass on each  
Other Panel. Topped  
with gathered  
spandex to resemble  
Barnacles.





Finally, Here is the  
use of the first  
embroidered Swirl  
design being used  
but it is replaced  
by Sea glass  
embroidery.

The Back has  
less of the glass  
but has the swirls  
to compliment the  
front.

The gathered  
waist pinching gives  
the illusion of  
bamboo to  
represent how  
they help break  
down the  
sea glass.
